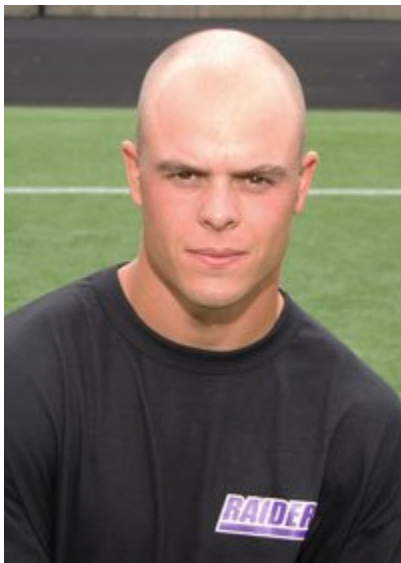

## *WATSON AND BLUME SET SIGHTS ON DIVISION I*

Assistant coaches Ross Watson and Dan Blume have both accepted graduate assistant positions at Division I schools. Watson has been hired as a defensive assistant at the University of Nebraska, a division I program that

plays in the Big 12 Conference. Blume has been hired at Villanova University, also as a defensive assistant. Villanova is located in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. The Wildcats compete at the Division I Championship level (formerly Division I-AA).

Watson is a 2006 graduate of Mount Union. Ross was voted team captain in 2005 as he was a four-year letter winner (2002-05) and three-year starter at cornerback for Mount Union. As a player, Watson earned First-Team All-Ohio Athletic Conference status and AFCA All-American honors in 2005. He led the team in interceptions his senior year with nine, one shy of the school record. For his career, he accumulated 146 hits, 14 interceptions and 29 passes broken up. Watson coached the cornerbacks for the past two seasons for the Purple Raiders.

Blume is a 2007 graduate of Mount Union. Dan played four years at linebacker as a member of the Purple Raiders (2002-05). He spent the 2006 season as a student assistant coach helping with the defensive line. The 2007 season was his first year as a full time assistant coach where he worked with the linebackers.
